
5-HALF SQUARE



Fabric A



Cutting Instructions:

Fabric A 4-7" x 7"

Fabric B 4-7" x 7"

Collect your cut fabrics.

Draw diagonal lines across the backs of the light colored squares, from one corner to the other.

Place a light square on top of a dark square, right sides together.

Stitch on the line.

Trim away one side, leaving a quarter inch seam allowance.

Open, pressing seam allowance towards the dark.

Repeat for remaining three sets.

Square up the four squares to $6 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

Arrange the four squares into a pinwheel shape.

Stitch the top and bottom together, using a ¼" seam allowance. Open, pressing seams in opposite directions.

Stitch the top and bottom together. Open and press seams In one direction.

Your block is complete!
